Name two types of Consequences:

1. Intended consequences &
2. Unintended consequences

As it relates to Wood working:

- Tim Killen is a master of intended consequences with the use of Sketch up and ability to create beautiful pieces of wood work.
- Unintended consequences often are associated with failed projects, accidents, or unsafe events.

Our goal as woodworkers should be:

- To maximize the number of intended consequences &
- To minimize the number of unintended consequences

Thinking and planning ahead should help us achieve the optimum balance of desired consequences.

Anticipate the possibilities and avoid unintended consequences: **work safely.**
